PROFILE SUMMARY

ANBD (Asia Network Beyond Design) was found in 2007 for the purpose of cultural value expansion through convergence of each area's characteristics. The first exhibition held in 2008 and 46 exhibitions displayed about 15,000 creations until now. ANBD tried to communicate beyond the genre of art and design for the last 14 years. From now on, we will challenge for the cultural convergence beyond Asia.



SPECIAL EXHIBITION

The ANBD special exhibition started in 2017 and has been celebrated for five consecutive years. The first event was successfully hosted in the Sapporo Special Exhibition in 2017, followed by Munich Special Exhibition in 2018, Colombo Special Exhibition in 2019, and JEJU Special Exhibition in 2020. In 2021, there were both many big and small changes in our society due to the influence of COVID19. Therefore, the 2021 Special Exhibition will be exhibited online with new attempts and meanings. New Normal THEME

The phrase "New Normal" is an oxymoron used to describe a life event that is unexpected or unfamiliar, often having a long-lasting or permanent impact on someone's day-to-day life. The COVID-19 pandemic is having an extreme impact on the artistic world. Measures on social distancing have limited the interaction between artists, eliminating many opportunities to gather and share. However, using the phrase to describe attempts to combat a global pandemic hints at a sense of permanence that makes a lot of people uncomfortable. This may be one time when it's better to challenge ourselves to find a new visual style, new technique, new expression, etc. rather than relying on one we have already done earlier.

EXHIBITION ENTRY FEE

- Exhibition Entry Fee differs with regions including printing, pamphlet and shipping fee.
 - Region 1 (Korea, Japan): US \$100
 - Region 2 (China, Taiwan): US \$80
 - Region 3 (Others): US \$60
 - Solo Exhibition: US \$1,000
- In the case of collaborative work, it is not the number of members, but exhibition cost will count per creation.
