Academic progression criteria for All Programmes

Year 1 to Year 2 – Not more than 05 accumulated failed modules

Notes

1. “Failed modules” mentioned here includes both “repeat modules” and “incomplete modules”.
 2. This is applicable to all the programs unless otherwise specified.
- The Head of department at their discretion may decide to allow students to proceed to the next year **ONLY** under the condition that they may take a maximum of **3 modules** (prorata or repeat in total) in addition to the normal semester workload.
 - Those who are not allowed to proceed to the next level will be eligible for a full refund and their registration will be cancelled (if already registered).
